Our legal help programs include:

- **Abuse and Crime Victims:** We can help you get protective orders, other legal help and support.
- **Eviction Hearings:** We may assist you at rent escrow and eviction hearings.
- **Pro Bono Program:** We may connect you with “pro bono” private lawyers. They give advice and representation for free.
- **Outreach and Education:** We reach out to farmworkers, tenants and crime victims, and to community partners looking to support clients with legal issues.
